§ 92.38 OWNERS RESPONSIBLE FOR TRIMMING, REMOVAL AND THE LIKE.

- (A) All property owners shall be responsible for the removal, cutting, or disposal and elimination of weeds, grasses and rank vegetation or other uncontrolled plant growth on their property, which at the time of notice, is in excess of 8 inches in height.
- (B) These provisions shall not apply to an area established with meadow vegetation if:
- (1) The prior vegetation is eliminated, and the meadow vegetation is planted through transplanting or seed by human or mechanical means; and
- (2) A sign is posted on the property in a location likely to be seen by the public, advising that a meadow or prairie is being established. This sign must be no smaller than ten inches square, no larger than one square foot, and no higher than three feet tall.
- (C) "Care & Maintenance of boulevards and adjacent property. Owners of property abutting the right-of-way of a public street or alley shall properly maintain the grass on the property and on the public right-of way to the curb line or traveled portion of the street or alley. Proper maintenance shall include sodding, planting, mowing, or weed abatement whenever necessary.
