- The contractor will be working on the storm sewer on 5<sup>th</sup> Street and McDermott Avenue. Concrete curb & gutter and driveways on 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and McLaughlin Ave.

## Looking Ahead

- The contractor will begin sub-cutting 7th Street, McDermott Avenue and 5<sup>th</sup> Street.

## Key Notes

- The public is urged to use caution throughout this construction season and to stay clear of all construction equipment & areas being actively worked on.
- Please use caution when driving on the roads of the project. Not all roads will be passible at all times. Use caution when roads are muddy due to rain.
- There may be times of temporary water shut downs as the contractor is working on temporary hook-ups and main installations.
- Once concrete is poured, it needs 7 days of cure time before any traffic is allowed on it. Please refrain from driving on any curb and gutter or driveways until after this time frame. Concrete can be walked on after 24 hours.
